HB 1530 - H COMM AMD

1 On page 6, after line 26, insert the following:

2 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 6. (1) ~~The commission may enter into an~~
3 ~~agreement regarding the transfer of park management~~
4 ~~responsibilities with an entity listed in RCW 79A.05.345 only if~~
5 ~~the entity has demonstrated~~(1) When entering into any agreements
6 ~~pursuant to 79A.05.345, the agency shall consider~~ when appropriate:

8 (a) ~~It~~ If the entity has an adequate source of available
9 funding to assume the financial responsibilities of the agreement;

10 ~~(b) It has broad support within the local community to~~
11 ~~undertake the management responsibilities of the agreement; and~~

12 ~~(eb) It~~ If the entity has sufficient expertise to assume the
13 scope of responsibilities ~~experience successfully managing~~
14 ~~projects of similar size and scope to the responsibilities of the~~
15 agreement.

16 ~~(c) If the agreement results in net financial benefits to the~~
17 ~~state; and~~

18 ~~(d) If the agreement results in advancement of state parks'~~
19 ~~public purpose.~~

20 ~~(2) The commission may not enter into any management transfer~~
21 ~~agreement that provides for the commission to fund, reimburse,~~
22 ~~subsidize or contribute to an entity's operating costs. This does~~
23 ~~not restrict the commission's ability to fund or contribute to any~~
24 ~~capital development, improvement or facility maintenance projects.~~

1 (32) Any ~~management transfer~~ agreement pursuant to this
2 section must include ~~terms for an initial trial period, no longer~~
3 ~~than one year, that include~~ specific performance measures. These
4 measures must cover, ~~the entity must meet before the agreement may~~
5 ~~be extended beyond a year. Performance measures may include,~~ but
6 are not limited to, the entity's ability to manage financial
7 operating costs, to adequately perform management
8 responsibilities, and to address and respond to ~~community public~~
9 concerns. The agreement ~~may~~ must provide that failure to meet any
10 performance measure may lead to the termination of the contract or
11 requirements for remedial action to be taken before the agreement
12 may be extended."

14 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct and
15 internal references accordingly.

EFFECT: Adds a new section establishing conditions for
park ~~management~~ agreements entered into by the ~~commission~~
agency.
